

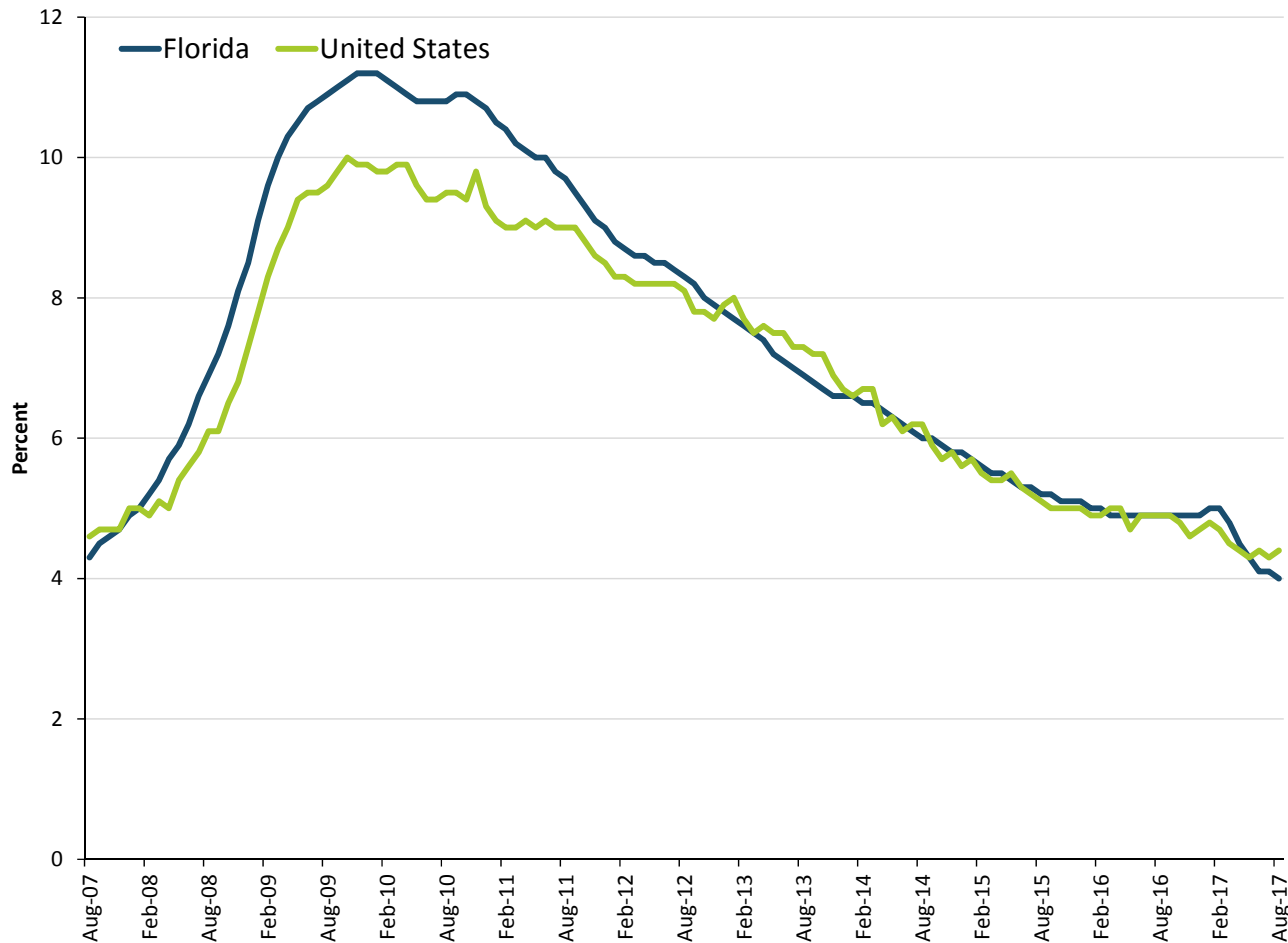
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### Florida's August Employment Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.0 percent in August 2017, down 0.1 percentage point from July 2017, and down 0.9 percentage point from a year ago. There were 408,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 10,095,000. The U.S. unemployment rate was 4.4 percent in August.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 8,649,900 in August 2017, an increase of 20,100 jobs (+0.2 percent) over the month. The state gained 221,400 jobs over the year, an increase of 2.6 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 1.4 percent over the year. Florida's over-the-year job growth rate has exceeded the nation's rate since May 2012.

## Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- The number of jobs in Florida was 8,649,900 in August 2017, up 221,400 jobs compared to a year ago. August 2017 was the 85<sup>th</sup> consecutive month with positive over-the-year job growth. The industry gaining the most jobs was professional and business services (+42,600 jobs, +3.3 percent).
- Other industries gaining jobs over the year included construction (+35,000 jobs, +7.3 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+32,300 jobs, +1.9 percent); education and health services (+30,500 jobs, +2.4 percent); leisure and hospitality (+27,900 jobs, +2.4 percent); other services (+21,800 jobs, +6.2 percent); manufacturing (+12,100 jobs, +3.4 percent); financial activities (+9,900 jobs, +1.8 percent); government (+8,800 jobs, +0.8 percent); and information (+400 jobs, +0.3 percent).

## Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In August 2017, Monroe County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (2.7 percent); followed by St. Johns County (3.2 percent); and Okaloosa and Walton counties (3.3 percent each).
- Hendry County had the highest unemployment rate (10.2 percent) in Florida in August 2017, followed by Hardee County (7.1 percent); and Glades County (6.3 percent).

## Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In August 2017, 23 out of 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford (+40,000 jobs, +3.3 percent); Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater (+39,600 jobs, +3.1 percent); and Ft. Lauderdale-Pompano Beach-Deerfield Beach (+26,900 jobs, +3.3 percent).
- The only metro area losing jobs over the year was Homosassa Springs (-200 jobs, -0.6 percent).

**Note:** The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
