

**Overview of the CareerSource Tampa Bay Region
Not Seasonally Adjusted
August 18, 2017**

- The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Tampa Bay region (Hillsborough County) was 4.1 percent in July 2017. This rate was 0.7 percentage point lower than the region's year ago rate of 4.8 percent. The region's July 2017 unemployment rate was 0.2 percentage point lower than the state rate of 4.3 percent. The labor force was 730,666, up 22,293 (+3.1) over the year. There were 29,596 unemployed residents in the region.
- In July 2017 nonagricultural employment in the Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater MSA was 1,324,100, an increase of 40,800 jobs (+3.2 percent) over the year.
- The Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater MSA had the highest annual job growth rate compared to all the metro areas in the state in other services (+11.2 percent) and information (+0.8 percent).
- The Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater MSA had the highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in professional and business services (+17,200 jobs); other services (+5,000 jobs); and information (+200 jobs) in July 2017.
- The Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater MSA had the second highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in mining, logging, and construction (+6,400 jobs) in July 2017.
- The other services (+11.2 percent); mining, logging, and construction (+9.1 percent); professional and business services (+7.4 percent); and information (+0.8 percent) industries grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year.
- The industries gaining in jobs over the year were: professional and business services (+17,200 jobs); mining, logging, and construction (+6,400 jobs); education and health services (+5,400 jobs); other services (+5,000 jobs); leisure and hospitality (+2,500 jobs); trade, transportation, and utilities (+2,300 jobs); financial activities (+1,200 jobs); government (+1,100 jobs); and information (+200 jobs).
- The manufacturing (-500 jobs) industry lost jobs over the year.
